The mood boards showed what everyone felt about gig buddies. Each table created a mood board and shared what they had created with the rest of the group.




We hope everyone had as much fun making them as we did hearing all about them.








Summer Preview

Pay what you can... What does it mean?

We understand that there is a cost of living crisis and that might mean that some gig buddies members find it difficult to afford to come to some of our social events.

You will notice that some of our social events are free and some say 'Pay what you can". If a social says this, that means that there is a choice for you to pay. You can either pay the full amount, if you can afford it, or part of the cost, or none at all.

You can either directly ask your local area coordinator at the event, or if it's easier, let them know in advance my text, email or call.

Many of our events are free, thanks to our partner venues and artists. Some events will say limited free spaces, this is because we can offer free tickets but only a limited amount.

Unfortunately there are limits to what we can offer, and we can't cover the cost of pub social meals and some pay as you go events.

Extra Help to Travel Cards

First bus have created a free resource for customers who may need extra help to travel.

These cut out and keep cards can be used to discreetly let the driver know if you need any additional support. You can cut them out and keep them in your wallet or purse and show to the driver when you get on the bus.

You can also visit their website: https://www.firstbus.co.uk/help-and-support/extra-help-travel
And take a screenshot of the cards to keep on your phone.
You could also take a photo of the card in the newsletter and keep it to show the bus driver.

These cards can be used on all public transport to let staff know if you have anything you need help with.
