This year, we launched our third stakeholder survey for members, partners, and service users. The aim of this survey was to develop a deeper understanding of how we can meet the ever-changing needs of organisations, individuals, and all stakeholders in the Voluntary Sector in West Lothian.

We want to thank everyone who took the time to complete the survey. The 2024 survey, completed by 34 organisations, was conducted between 19th September and 11th October and saw a 30% increase in responses compared to last year. This year's survey also included specific questions for Social Enterprises, as we enhance our support for this vital group.




Q1. Over the last 12 months how often have you engaged with The Gateway?








Q7. How effective is The Gateway at capturing your organisations views and comments to represent the sector?

Q9. How useful is our website?




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
Q10. Is there anything different or additional you would like to see on our website?




Q11. What events/training/awareness sessions do you think we should be hosting for the sector?




Q12. Does The Gateway do enough to support volunteering?



Q13. What areas of governance support would you like to see more of?




Q14. Do the benefits and services you receive from The Gateway make you feel valued as a member/stakeholder?



Q15. What is your biggest concern for your own organisation over the next 12 months?




Q16. How much effort is your organisation dedicating towards Net Zero initiatives?




Q17. How optimistic do you feel about the future?



Q18. Are you a member of the Voluntary Sector Gateway West Lothian?




Q19. What is your income bracket?




Q21. Did your Social Enterprise make a profit in the last financial year?
